

PRAIRIE CONCLAVE LEADERSHIP EDUCATION GRANT GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION

The Prairie Conclave of American Folk Dancers operated as a non-profit organization from 1976 through 2015 for the purpose of gathering dance leaders on a biannual basis to exchange information, to develop programs, and to guide, promote, and safeguard square and round dancing in the Central United States.

The Prairie Conclave Board is making available grants of up to \$500 to encourage square and round dancing leadership education in Nebraska and Kansas. These grants will be awarded until the funds of the Prairie Conclave treasury are expended.

- ❖ Grants are available to any square or round dance organization such as clubs, federations, districts or state associations in Kansas or Nebraska.
- ❖ Grants will be awarded in support of activities that promote leadership skills and/or training of organization officers, callers or cuers.
- ❖ Grants may be used for special educational opportunities associated with dances, conventions, festivals or weekends, but may not be used in direct support of caller or cuer fees or facility rental.
