

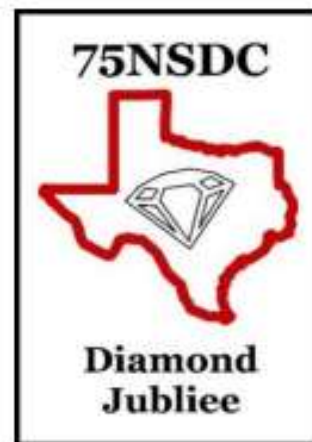

What's Cooking

HAM BALLS

Preheat oven to 350° F.

Ingredients

- 3 lbs ground ham
- 2 lbs ground pork
- 1 lb ground beef
- 3 eggs beaten
- 3 c graham cracker crumbs
- 2 c milk

Mix meat ingredients and shape into balls of about 1/3 c each

Sauce

- 2 cans tomato soup (undiluted)
- 3/4 c vinegar
- 2 1/2 c brown sugar
- 2 tsp dry mustard

Combine and pour over meat

Bake at 350° for 1 hour



PINEAPPLE ANGEL FOOD CAKE

Preheat oven to 350° F.

Ingredients

- 1 box 1 step angel food cake mix
- 1 20oz can crushed pineapple (with juice)

Directions:

Mix together in a mixing bowl and pour into 9x13 cake pan.

Bake at 350° for 35 minutes or until done.

My dad made this once and mixed it right in the 9x13 cake pan and it came out fine.
