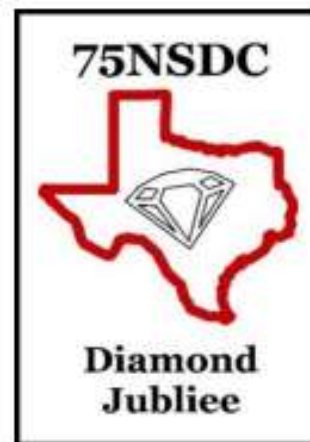



What's Cooking

CROCKPOT CHICKEN AND NOODLES

Ingredients

- 2 cans cream of chicken soup
- 2 cans chicken broth (15oz each)
- 1 stick-butter or margarine
- 1 lb chicken breasts (fresh or frozen)
- 1 package frozen egg noodles (24 oz)
- 1 used Reames

In crockpot put chicken on bottom.
Pour the chicken broth and soup on top.
Then top that with the stick of butter.
Put the crockpot on low for 6-7 hours.
Take the chicken out and shred.
Put back in crockpot, add the frozen noodles and cook for 2 more hours.



Cheesy Bacon Bites

Ingredients

- 4 ounces Cream Cheese (softened)
- ¼ cup Real Bacon Pieces
- 2 tablespoons Onion (chopped)
- 8 ounces Refrigerated Crescent Roll Dough

Directions:

Preheat oven to 375°F. In Small Batter Bowl, combine cream cheese, bacon, onion and black pepper; mix well.

Unroll crescent dough; separate into 2 rectangles on Cutting Board. Press perforations together to seal. Spread cream cheese mixture on each rectangle using All-Purpose Spreader. Starting at longest side, roll up each rectangle, jelly-roll fashion; press seams together to seal.

Cut each roll into 16 slices using Bread Knife. Place slices, cut side down, on Large Bar Pan. Bake 15-17 minutes or until golden brown. Serve warm.
